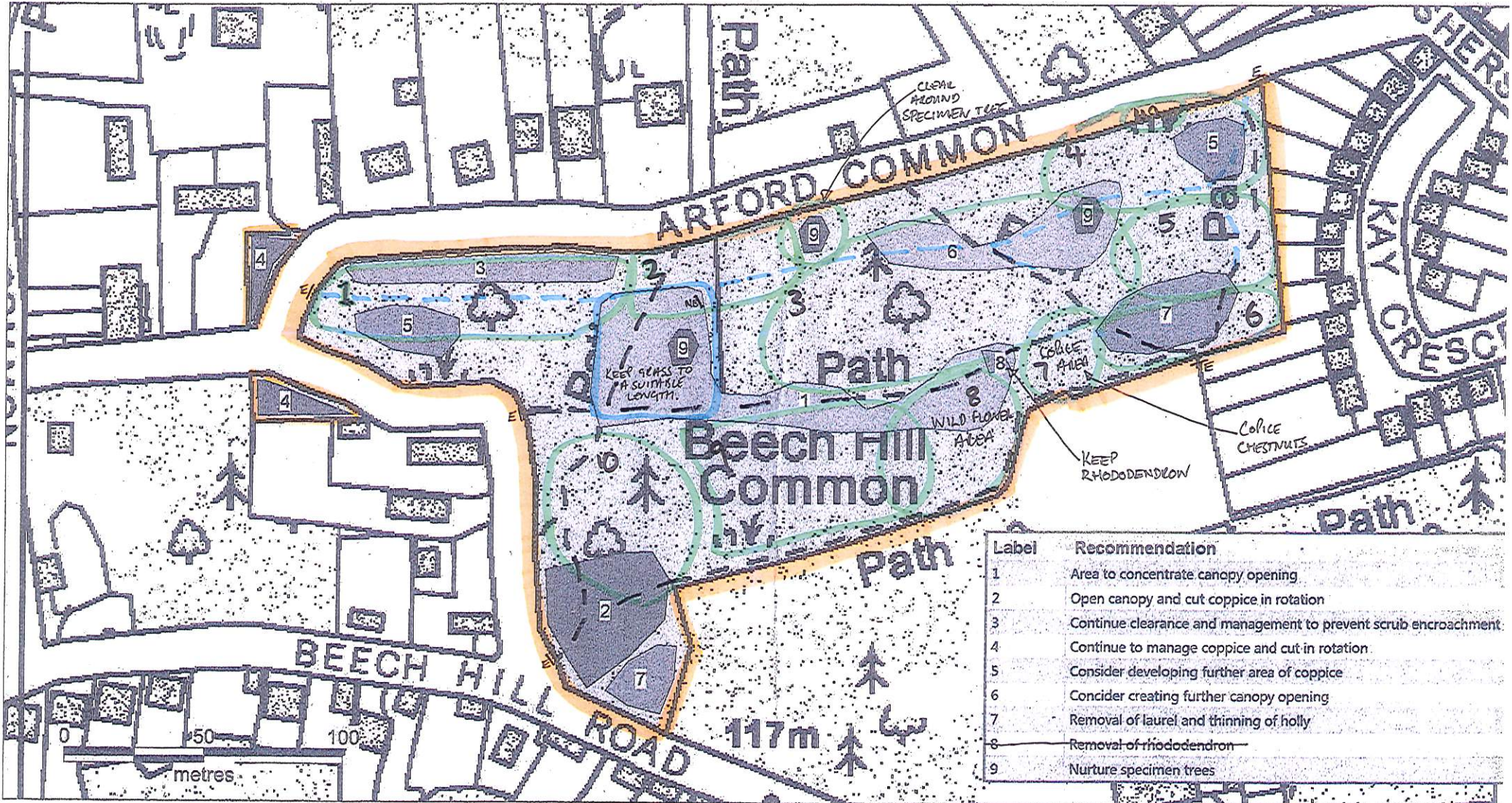
GENERAL / OVERVIEW:

- KEEP SOME LOGS / BRANCHES FOR HABITAT
- MAINTAIN PATHS
- ALLOW AREAS TO RE-ESTABLISH; SOME TRAINING OF SAPLINGS.

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Label	Recommendation
1	Area to concentrate canopy opening
2	Open canopy and cut coppice in rotation
3	Continue clearance and management to prevent scrub encroachment
4	Continue to manage coppice and cut in rotation
5	Consider developing further area of coppice
6	Consider creating further canopy opening
7	Removal of laurel and thinning of holly
8	Removal of rhododendron
9	Nurture specimen trees
