

Community Infrastructure Levy

Funding Report February 2020

The Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) is a charge that local authorities can set on new development in order to raise funds to help fund the infrastructure, facilities and services.

East Hants District Council collects CIL and passports payment to the relevant Town or Parish Council.

The neighbourhood portion of the levy can be spent of a wide range of things, provided it meets the requirement to 'support the development of the area'.

If a Parish or Town Council does not spend the levy within 5 year of receipt or does not spend it on initiatives that support the development of the area, East Hants District Council may require some or all it to be repaid.
